

WP5 - IMPACT ASSESSMENT REPORT

Introduction

The following Impact assessment report was developed based on Paolo Federighi's framework provided for WP5 and the pilots' organization. The main purpose of the report is for partners to describe their piloting work and to collect the feedback, provided by participants of the workshops. The partners are asked to converse about the situation of adult education in their local environment/region and collect the feedback that will, later on, be the basis of the roadmap with the policy recommendations.

The pilot activities focused on the following aspects.

- 1. Upscaling of the peer learning activities and capacity building for adult education institutions at the local/regional level
- 2. Regular meetings with local/regional adult education institutions, employment agencies and other key stakeholders
- 3. Setting up/strengthening a regional/local adult education institution network or a project local unit (*two clusters*)
- 4. Further dissemination

Context analysis

L&W's pilot activity focused on adult essential skills, looking in particular at adult numeracy skills.

In the UK, around 9m adults have low skills in literacy and/or numeracy. In 2022, the UK Government launched Multiply, a new 3-year £560m national programme focussed on adult numeracy. Each Mayoral Combined Authority (MCA - regional government) or local authority (outside MCA areas) has received a share of this funding to commission and deliver Multiply activity. The regional and local aspects



of the programme funding and delivery mean that it is ideally aligned with RegALE objectives to build capacity in adult learning and education at the regional level.

Multiply delivery is intended to complement formal adult numeracy provision, and can include non-formal learning activities to engage adults, including delivery in the workplace, community and family learning settings and delivery of numeracy in everyday contexts, such as financial literacy.

L&W's pilot activity aimed to establish a new Multiply Effective Practice Network for key stakeholders – including policy makers at the local, regional and national levels, commissioners, adult learning providers and practitioners – to share and develop practice in relation to the delivery of the Multiply adult numeracy programme. This responds to a gap in the Government's commissioning of the programme, in that few opportunities for collaboration and exchange were envisaged or provided. Through the RegALE activity, L&W aims to create an opportunity for exchange, informed by L&W's wider research evidence on effective practice in adult basic and life skills.

In this, we also respond to key findings of the RegALE report on Adult Learning and Education Policies and Practice in Europe, which highlights the need for professional development opportunities for adult learning practitioners. This is particularly important in relation to non-formal adult numeracy learning, which is a feature of the Multiply programme. In recent years in the UK, much adult numeracy provision has been focused on formal learning and qualifications. We anticipate that the Multiply Effective Practice Network will provide an opportunity to develop practitioners' skills in the delivery of non-formal learning, and promote the benefits of non-formal approaches to a wide range of educational stakeholders.

Pilots

Activities

The network provides a forum for all Multiply commissioners, providers and wider stakeholders with a strategic interest and expertise in adult numeracy to share experiences and learn from other areas as the Multiply programme evolves, in real time.

The MEPN aims to support Multiply commissioners and providers by:



- Providing forums to share what's working well, and local innovation
- Sharing solutions to common challenges in commissioning and delivering
- Supporting access to evidence-based insight into what works in adult numeracy provision

In this, it builds on earlier work by L&W to support local authorities to plan Multiply delivery, which included data modelling to <u>map basic skills needs</u> in every local authority area of England, and sharing our evidence on '<u>what works' in adult basic skills provision</u>.

The following activities have taken place:

- 1. L&W's Chief Executive Officer, Stephen Evans, convened a private online roundtable for Mayoral Combined Authority adult skills policy leads on 29th April 2022 to discuss their plans for Multiply commissioning and delivery, along with any challenges they were experiencing or anticipated in relation to the programme. This session helped to shape the MEPN offer prior to the development of the pilot activity.
- 2. **A MEPN launch event**, delivered as part of L&W's annual ESOL, maths and English conference held online on 8th November 2022. The launch event included input from local authorities and Mayoral Combined Authorities who shared their plans for the commissioning and delivery of Multiply.
- 3. Following the launch event, a <u>MEPN webpage</u> was created and dissemenated to support enable stakeholders to sign up to the network. A scoping survey was then sent out to all members to collect information about their planning and delivery of Multiply to date, the challenges they faced in planning and delivering Multiply, effective or innovative approaches taken so far and suggestions for MEPN activity. The survey received 17 responses.
- 4. The first MEPN webinar focusing on effective practice in recruitment and engagement of adult learners was held on 28th February 2023. This webinar was aimed at those involved in the commissioning and delivery of the Multiply programme. The webinar aimed to:



- Build understanding of what works to support recruitment and engagement of adults into numeracy learning.
- Share learning on challenges faced and effective practice in relation recruitment and engagement of adults onto Multiply so far.

The webinar included:

- Existing research: what works to support recruitment and engagement of adult learners into numeracy and other essential skills.
- Expert input: learnings from two local areas on innovative approaches to supporting recruitment and engagement of adult learners (with Q&A).
- Interactive discussion: an opportunity to discuss and share effective practice approaches, and useful resources and materials with others involved in the delivery of Multiply.

Engagement and participation

Participants

The participation in each activity is summarised below. Further details for the network membership and webinar are included in the annex.

- Mayoral Combined Authority private online roundtable. Chair: Stephen Evans, CEO, L&W. Participants included representatives of MCAs, including Greater London, West Midlands, Liverpool City Region, Greater Manchester, West of England, Tees Valley, North of Tyne and Cambridgeshire and Peterborough. The session explored opportunities and challenges in relation to Multiply, and how L&W activity could support commissioners and providers in future.
- Launch Event. Speakers: Alex Stevenson, Head of Essential Skills, L&W (chair); Katherine Radlett, Principal Policy Officer Multiply, Greater London Authority; Parminder Singh Garcha Adult Education Policy Lead, Cambridgeshire and Peterborough Combined Authority; Ian Bond, Director of Learning, Inspire Nottinghamshire (provider). The local government representatives outlined their plans, aspirations and anticipated challenges in relation to the Multiply Programme. Delegates in the session included adult education providers and practitioners.



- MEPN Network Sign Up and survey. 246 adult learning providers, practitioners and stakeholders signed up for network membership. Of these, 17 organisations responded to our network survery, to help shape priorities for the webinar programme.
- MEPN Webinar on engaging adult learners. Speakers: Hazel Klenk, Research Manager, L&W and Alex Stevenson, Head of Essential Skills, L&W. Contributors: Amanda Pavon-Lopez, Multiply Co-ordinator, Haringey Learns, London Borough of Haringey; Hannah Ball, Multiply Programme Manager, Skills & Learning Adult Community Education, Bournemouth, Christchurch, and Poole Council. 100 webinar participants, representing 75 organisations, participated in an interactive discussion to share practice around the challenges in engaging adults in numeracy learning and approaches to engaging and recruiting learners to participate.

Stakeholders' involvement

Stakeholder involvement was generally good, indicated by the overall response to the invitations to join MEPN (see above and annex).

Analysis shows a good range and coverage of adult education providers involved in the Multiply programme, along with local authorities and local and national policy makers across all regions of England. There remains scope to engage further stakeholders in these areas. Capacity and availability may have affected the ability of some organisations to take part. Additionally, the speed of implementation of Multiply varies between local areas – those who have not yet started may benefit from future activity to encourage MEPN sign-up.

The main limitation is that Multiply is a UK-wide programme, but MEPN is primarily focused on England only. Future network activity will need to consider the roll-out of the Multiply programme in Scotland, Wales and Northern Ireland. This might provide a valuable opportunity for exchange between adult education providers in the four UK nations, which does not commonly take place due to the different education systems in place and devolved education and skills policy in each country.

Lessons learnt

Challenges and obstacles

Few challenges were experienced. However, given that the Multiply programme is new, some policymakers felt unable to share their plans more widely, and initially providers were less confident to share details of their activity until its quality and impact could be demonstrated. This was mitigated by a wide range of stakeholder engagement to give a choice of potential contributors to MEPN activity.

Enablers

Key enablers for the MEPN network include:

- **Relevance**: The Multiply programme is of considerable interest to providers and other stakeholders. This benefitted recruitment to the network.
- Engagement of national policy makers. Although Multiply is planned and delivered regionally and locally, it is a national policy initiative. Early engagement with the Department for Education ensured that it welcomed the MEPN activity as complementary to the policy initiative, and the DfE team often referred to MEPN in their own engagement with local and regional stakeholders in the sector sector as a useful resource.
- RegALE piloting funding. Network activities require time and capacity to
 design and deliver. Project funding for the RegALE piloting has enabled
 L&W to co-ordinate this network activity. However, beyond the lifespan of
 RegALE, we will need to secure alternative resources.

Future opportunities and exploitation

The MEPN network pilot activity had demonstrated clear demand and need for space where providers and other stakeholders can collaborate on effective practice in the delivery of the Multiply programme.

L&W will seek to build upon the pilot by securing funding, such as event sponsorship, to continue with the development and delivery of a Multiply webinar programme for the remainder of the programme (until early 2025).

Stakeholders feedback

Will the initiative plan to be capable to produce more dialogue and cooperation between various stakeholders at the regional and local levels?

Will the network development project be able to produce more dialogue and cooperation between various stakeholders?

All of the stakeholders who provided feedback on the webinar said they found it useful or very useful. Attendees found it useful to hear from other providers about the approaches they are taking to plan and deliver Multiply. They also highly valued the opportunity to share ideas and interact with other providers. This suggests the potential for further collaboration in future via MEPN.

"It was a good mix of research, practical examples that were very different, and an opportunity to share opinions." (Webinar participant)

In your opinion, should other current problems or actions be considered priorities?

As MEPN focuses on a defined, specific area of policy and delivery, this is unlikely to be necessary while that the Multiply programme continues. In future, it will be necessary to consider the value of a network focused on adult numeracy, once the Multiply initiative concludes.

In your opinion, should a different model and function be considered?

Participant feedback suggested some amendments to the MEPN webinar model, including:

- Having more space to hear from different kinds of providers
- Longer sessions, to allow more time for discussion
- Breakout sessions, to facilitate greater opportunities for interaction between participants.

Do you forecast some kind of obstacles for future cooperation?

The main challenge will be securing resource to sustain the network activities, though we have had some interest from stakeholders in sponsoring future events.

Dissemination activities

Dissemination of activities is via L&W channels, including the website, social media and our annual conference on English, maths and ESOL for adults. The MEPN network contacts gained through the pilot activity will be a valuable resource for future activity. The audience reached was in -line with expected results and we



consider the overall response to be good. As noted above, extending the reach to all parts of the UK could be a future objective for the network. Strategic conversations with L&W Wales, the Forum for Adult Learning in Northern Ireland and Education Scotland have taken place to explore how this might be achieved.

Conclusions

The MEPN pilot activity has demonstrated a need and demand for collaboration between adult education providers, practictioners and commissioners / policy makers around the delivery of the Multiply adult numeracy programme. As the programme is commissioned and delivered locally, there is the risk of providers lacking opportunities to learn about how the programme is implemented in other areas. MEPN provides a space where this can happen.

This serves to validate the premise of the RegALE project collaboration, in that there is much that can be done at regional and local level to strengthen and build capacity for adult learning and education. The MEPN pilot demonstrates that, where there is a relevant and defined focus, engagement of a wide range of stakeholders, and resourcing to support the co-ordination of regional capacity building activity, regional networking and capacity building has a role to play in support the development of adult education provision, and the professional knowledge and skills of adult education practitioners.
